



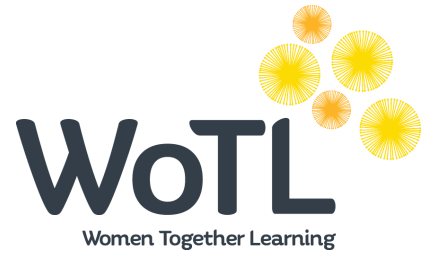
Cleve Women's Crop Walk
