Agricultural Innovation & Research Eyre Peninsula (AIR EP) was founded with the aim of creating a single entity for farmer driven applied research, local validation and extension of agricultural technologies and innovations on the Eyre Peninsula.

Our small, dedicated team accesses funds to support projects that address key issues and opportunities that will increase the profitability and resilience of farming businesses. Currently, AIR EP has 26 active projects with a total value to almost \$4.5 million, and completed an additional 12 projects valued over \$2 million in 2024. The number of active projects will increase in 2025, as AIR EP continues to field collaboration requests from research organisations and farming system groups.

With a reach of 400+ local farmers and agribusiness representatives, AIR EP plays a key role in influencing the adoption of new and innovative farm practices across the region.

What's in store for 2025

2025 is shaping to be another big year for AIR EP!

With event and extension planning well underway, along with the commencement of several new projects, the team is looking forward to delivering and supporting a variety of workshops, crop walks, podcasts, and forums across the region.

The annual AIR EP Member Days will be held 11-13 February in three locations across the EP, reaching a broad network of farmers and industry members. Guest speaker Michael Moodie, Frontier Farming Systems will delve into 'Pre-sowing' decisions, risks and data to assist farmers in preparing for a successful start to the cropping season.

In partnership with the EP Landscape Board, AIR EP will deliver free *Introduction to Carbon Farming* workshops to the region. Participants will receive a thorough overview of the concepts of carbon farming and how it can enhance on-farm efficiency and output. Six workshops will be delivered from 24-27 March.

AIR EP will support the Australian Rural Leadership Foundation in delivering four, 2-day "Changemaker" workshops to locations across the EP from 2-24 June. The workshop series is funded via the FRRR Community Impact Program of which AIR EP is the Lead Organisation.


